- Up-gradation / Renovation of existing schools; and

HEALTH

- Development of primary health centers;
- Provision of 30 bed hospital with all facilities and free medicines;
- Ambulance to take patients to hospitals in emergency situations;
- A mobile medical van to conduct health campaigns which will lead to better conditions of the people;
- Conduction of vaccination / immunization programmes including polio camps;
- Eye camps; and
- Provision of homeopathic doctor for free homeopathic consultation and free medicine

DRINKING WATER FACILITY

Pure and Safe drinking water to meet daily household water requirement

SANITATION

Proper sewerage system will be created and will start Suvidha Public Toilet (SPT) at project site and adjoining villages

VOCATIONAL TRAINING

- Bakery , Papad and Agarbathi making
- Computer Training
- Candle making
- Fashion technology courses
- Food preservation
- Handicraft
- Mushroom cultivation

- Organize skill development and vocational training for enabling people to form self help group
- Printing press, Spiral binding and Screen printing
- Spices grinding and packing
- Tailoring Embroidery classes to surrounding villagers
- Training for girls and ladies of weaker section of society
- Type writers and Shorthand training
- Welders

SELF EMPLOYMENT

Support would be given to people who want to generate self employment like some shops, small businesses like poultry, etc. will be provided financial assistance up to Rs.50,000/-.
